**Byzantine Earrings    £19.00pp    (B/I)**

In this class you'll learn to create the beautiful byzantine chainmaille link. We'll also teach you to create wrapped loops to securely attach your chosen beads to the bottom of your byzantine section to complete your earrings.

You will need:  
28 x 7/8mm SP jump rings  
4x 4mm SP jump rings  
2 x SP 2" head pins,  
Pair of earwires  
2 x beads of your choice

**Macramé and Pearls    £19.00pp    (E)**

Learn how to make a beautiful satin macramé bracelet studded with real pearls. We'll teach you the macramé knotting technique that will allow you to showcase some beautiful pearls and you can make these without metal...good for those sensitive to metals.

You will need:  
7 x 7 - 8mm freshwater pearls with holes of at least 2mm  
2 x smaller beads for ends (optional)

Satin Rattail Cord will be provided

**Wrapped Earrings    £18.00pp    (B/I)**

In this class you'll learn to create a pair of intricate wire wrapped earrings. We'll teach you wrapped loops and wrapped bails, useful when working with odd shaped stoned like briolettes..

You will need:  
Pair of earwires  
2 x Gemstone/Glass briolette beads  
2 x through-drilled beads of your choice

All wire will be provided.

**Pearl Knotting    £25.00pp    (B/I)**

We've all seen them - fabulous scarves of pearls adorning jeweller's window displays. Now you can make your own for a fraction of the cost and in a colour scheme of your choice. Basic pearl knotting will be taught on this class.

You will need:  
3 - 4 x 16" strands of pearls - all same colour fine but mixed sizes and colours add texture & interest  
2 x larger feature pearls/gemstones for the ends

**Needles, thread and findings will be provided.**

**Kumihimo Basics £25 pp incl. all materials (E)**

Kumihimo literally means 'gathered thread' in Japanese and this ancient braiding technique is currently experiencing something of a renaissance. This class introduces you to the technique, discusses the tools required and possibilities for design. Your aim is to complete a simple bracelet, the first stepping stone on your Kumihimo journey.

We provide all the materials you will use in the class!

**Tangled Jewellery    £18.00pp    (B)**

A great way to showcase spectacular beads. This class lets you create sculptural wire pieces of miniature art. Take one-off or special beads and use a wire-wrapping technique to 'frame' them.

You will need:  
Pair of ear wires  
3 x beads of your choice, 2 smaller for earrings  
1 x necklace for the pendant

All extra wire will be provided

**Necklace Basics    £16.00pp    (E)**

In this class we'll teach you the fundamental techniques used to make numerous different styles of necklace. We'll discuss and practice various methods of ending necklaces and go over the terminology for describing the findings used. You'll have the opportunity on the night to purchase beads to make up a necklace of your chosen style.

All wire and findings will be provided

**THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW :**

- A minimum number of participants are required for a class to go ahead. Should we have to cancel a class for any reason you will be offered the choice of another class or a full refund.
