


# Classes Spring/Sumer 2018

	<p><b><u>Byzantine Earrings</u></b>    £20pp    Tuesday 03.04.18    7.00– 9.00pm</p> <p>In this class you'll learn to create the beautiful byzantine chainmaille link. We'll also teach you to create wrapped loops to securely attach your chosen beads to the bottom of your byzantine section to complete your earrings.</p> <p>You will need:</p> <table border="0"> <tr> <td>28 x 7/8mm SP jump rings</td> <td>2 x SP 2" head pins,</td> </tr> <tr> <td>4x 4mm SP jump rings</td> <td>Pair of earwires</td> </tr> <tr> <td></td> <td>2 x beads of your choice</td> </tr> </table> <p>Any extra findings and all tools will be provided</p>	28 x 7/8mm SP jump rings	2 x SP 2" head pins,	4x 4mm SP jump rings	Pair of earwires		2 x beads of your choice
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	<p><b><u>Tin Cup Necklace</u></b>    £20pp    Wednesday 18.04.18    6.30pm – 8.30pm</p> <p>The 'tin cup' necklace is the perfect piece to learn how to knot pearls and beads. By the end of this class you'll have learned how to knot pearls into position and end a threaded necklace. If we've time we'll also show you how to use your newly acquired skills to make beautiful matching earrings!</p> <p>You will need:</p> <p>19x6mm–10mm freshwater pearls (approx)          (Optional – 38 Preciosa 4mm bicone crystals)          Griffin Thread (Silk or Nylon) with needle size dependent on pearl drill holes</p> <p>Any extra findings and all tools will be provided</p>						
	<p><b><u>Tangled Jewellery</u></b>    £20pp    Wednesday 09.05.18    7.00pm–9.00pm</p> <p>A great way to showcase spectacular beads. This class allows you to create sculptural wire pieces of miniature art. Take one-off or special beads and use a wire-wrapping technique to 'frame' them.</p> <p>You will need:</p> <p>Pair of ear wires          3 x beads of your choice, 2 smaller for earrings</p> <p>All wire will be provided</p>						
	<p><b><u>Dewdrop Illusion Necklace</u></b>    £20pp    Wednesday 23.05.18    6.30pm–8.00pm</p> <p>This is one of the best ways to learn the fundamentals of necklace and bracelet making. You'll learn about components, positioning, how to crimp and how to end a tigertail necklace using clamshell ends.</p> <p>You will need:</p> <p>9 x focal beads – 8mm or larger          18 x Preciosa 4mm bicone crystals</p> <p>Tigertail and findings will be provided</p>						

KEY: sp – silver plated, gp – gold plated,  
 E – Everyone (suitable for complete novices and everyone else),  
 I – intermediate (some appropriate beading experience beneficial but not always necessary),  
 A – Advanced ( appropriate beading experience necessary)

	<p><b><u>Pretty Weave Set</u>    £20pp    Wednesday 13.06.18    6.30pm – 8.00pm</b></p> <p>You'll learn how to make a weave style necklace incorporating beads of your choice. You can make it dramatic, bold, long, simple, pretty – whatever you want! We'll also show you how to make matching earrings All wire and findings will be provided.</p> <p>You will need:  7-9 x 8mm or larger focal beads  14-18 x 4mm accent beads  30-40 x 2/3mm accent beads</p> <p>Any extra findings and all tools will be provided</p>
	<p><b><u>Beading Basics</u>    £49pp    Sunday 24.06.18    12noon -4.30pm</b></p> <p>Learn how to make jewellery basics – necklace, bracelet and earrings. Using different beading mediums, we'll teach you how to make a single strand beaded necklace, an elasticated bracelet and wired earrings. We'll teach you ending, tying off knots, creating loops and much more.... In fact, you get 30 minutes for lunch as it's pretty full on!</p> <p>You will need:  40cm-50cm selection of beads for the necklace  15cm-20cm selection of beads for the bracelet with 0.6mm holes or larger)  1cm-3cm paired selection of beads for the earrings</p> <p>All wires and findings will be provided</p>
	<p><b><u>Pearl Knotting</u>    £25pp    Saturday 08.07.18    12noon-3.00pm</b></p> <p>We've all seen them - fabulous scarves of pearls adorning jeweller's window displays. Now you can make your own for a fraction of the cost and in a colour scheme of your choice. Basic pearl knotting will be taught on this class.</p> <p>You will need:  3-4 x 16" strands of pearls - all same colour fine but mixed sizes and colours add texture &amp; interest  2 x larger feature pearls/gemstones for the ends.  Griffin needled thread (to be advised on the day once your beads have been assessed)</p> <p>Findings will be provided.</p>

Bring along any projects you want advice on and the teacher (and others) will offer to help.</p> <p>Please note that even though this evening is free we still require you to book so that we know how many are coming.
